#### Implementation

- Business software is NOT designed for education
- Carefully review technology and software

- Don't assume that students read your instructions
- Keep instructions simple and offer additional guidance

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### **Examples of Selection Criteria:**

- Facilitating and leading discussions with project and business stakeholders to map as-is and to-be processes and procedures
- Analysing workflow to create process maps and isolate areas of potential improvement
- Work closely with stakeholders to manage and define requirements and user stories, including acceptance criteria
- Demonstrated experience in delivering agile initiatives in high performing teams
- Strong analytical and problem solving skills
- Stakeholder collaboration for problem solving
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills
- Flexibility to swap roles in a project team

"is used by artists to show employers their versatility by showing different samples of current work. Typically, the work reflects an artist's best work or a depth in one specific area of work." (Wikipedia)






### A digital portfolio in the BIS Mcom specialization

- Encourage reflection on job relevant skills covered in units

- Ability to communicate work relevant knowledge obtained effectively

- Appreciate the relevance of working on unstructured problems

- Talk about experiences working in teams and on projects




### INFS5002 an example

- Major component in INFS5002 is a group project with weekly deliveries and meetings with an industry partner.
- At end of semester: Students develop a 500 word portfolio entry:
  - Showcase the work they have done on the group project
  - Future employers as intended audience
  - Communicates clearly personal contribution made for successful completion
  - Demonstrate a student's skill set, including the ability to work in a team environment
- The rubric for marking emphasizes ability to express transferable skills over summaries of tasks completed.

## There are 'Roomies' and 'Zoomies'....








But how do we build a connection across 'Roomies' and 'Zoomies'?






## **Five Hybrid considerations**

### 1. Vision: e.g.

- Can Roomies see Zoomies?
- Can Zoomies see Roomies?
- Can Zoomies see the room via "lectern" and educator's cam?
- 2. Voice/Sound: e.g
  - Are Zoomies just listening in?
  - Do Roomies dominate the discussion?
  - How will you determine who has the 'Mic'?



## **Five Hybrid considerations**

### **3.** Connections: e.g.

- Can Roomies and Zoomies 'chat'?
- Will Breakouts be within or across Roomies and Zoomies?


### 4. Contributions: e.g

- Will Roomies and Zoomies contribute ideas using the same technology?
  - Eg Everyone on padlet?
  - Or Roomies on physical Whiteboards and Zoomies on digital ones?

### 5. Clarity: e.g.

- Will we rename ourselves Roomies and Zoomies?
- What Edtech will I use?
- Do I even know what it is like to be a Zoomie in a hybrid class?
